Based on the operating data provided, your 21 CHP projects have avoided emissions of an estimated 55,700 metric tons of carbon dioxide, compared to conventional energy sources. This includes 2013 avoided emissions of more than 12,000 metric tons, equal to those from the generation of electricity used annually by 1,645 homes.
